Language learning

Our language programs for Ukrainians offer two main options to learn and practice new languages. Both options provide valuable opportunities to improve language skills and integrate into new communities.

Language Courses

Structured online courses led by experienced volunteer teachers, supported by TEEI's education team. Teachers can use their own curriculum or TEEI-provided materials. Courses run 2-3 times a week for 2-3 months.

Language Connect for Ukraine

A digital hub connecting Ukrainians with international volunteers for flexible 1-1 video sessions to practice language skills.

The time commitment for the volunteers on the platform is flexible, as they can revise their availability anytime.



The two programs offer different options for Ukrainians to learn a new language, whether through a structured online course or through more flexible 1-1 video sessions. Both programs provide valuable opportunities for Ukrainians to improve their language skills.

TEACHER RESOURCES

TEACHING MATERIAL

This includes materials from reputable sources such as Babbel and Oxford University Press, which are designed to be engaging and interactive and to help students develop their language skills in a way that is practical and applicable to real-life situations.

VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

In addition to the materials, we provide our teachers with access to our own video platform that allows for real-time interaction with their students. This platform is designed to be user-friendly and accessible, and to allow teachers to easily communicate with their students and provide them with feedback and support.





LMS

We also offer our teachers access to TEEI Itslearning, our cloud-based Learning Management System (LMS), that allows them to track their students' progress, provide additional resources and materials, and communicate with their students outside of class time. Itslearning is designed to be easy to use, and provides teachers with the tools they need to effectively manage their classes and support their students' learning.
